### **CITY COUNCIL**

### **APPLE PARK**

### **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Assistant Chief Thompson is on duty Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Jeff Trotnic, our Chief of Police, has irregular hours. If you would like to speak to him please feel free to contact the City Hall and leave your name and number. He is very punctual about returning calls. We also have patrol through the evenings and the weekends. They are always happy to assist you.

On the form you may add who is or isn't allowed on your property and anything you would like checked specifically (outside the home).
